SUBJECT: Certificate of Networkiness (CoN) for Automated Technical Order
Management System (ATOMS (D359)) Version 2.0 SP2

1. ATOMS (D359) version 2.0 SP2 is compliant with Air Force policy and is hereby issued CoN number CoN1-2000391-190804-00-0.
2. An assessment determined the overall risk rating for ATOMS (D359), version 2.0 SP2 is low and does not adversely impact the security, network compatibility and interoperability of the Air Force Terrestrial, Air and Space Communications Network. AFCA has confirmed that the passwords are now masked. Therefore, the timed condition identified in the previous CoN (ref. b) is met with the release and implementation of Version 2.0 SP2. Per the Program Manager, all users of ATOMS version 2.0 shall migrate to ATOMS version 2.0 SP2 NLT 31 Oct 04. Note that the timed condition for ATOMS version 2.0 will not be lifted or resolved.
3. This CoN is for this version only. The Program Manager must notify the POC below of any subsequent releases or changes to the system's security, interoperability, or sustainability to determine if a new networkiness assessment is required.
